CIRCULAR

Sub: Implementation of Business reform action plan - 2017 – Reform in Inspection Procedures.

Ref: Office circular No. EST-1/MISC/CR-54/2016-17, Dated: 06.08.16.


In continuation to circular at reference, the department has further modified the Inspection Procedure system to implement recommendations of **Business reform action plan - 2017** in respect of;

1. Design and implement a-system for computerised allocation of inspectors
2. Mandate that the same inspector will not inspect the same establishment twice consecutively

In this regard in addition to the mandated instructions at circular at reference, the following system and instructions shall be followed:

1. The factories which are once inspected by the officer shall not be inspected by the same officer twice consecutively.
2. The next inspection of the same factory, in case selected for random inspection shall be carried out by the next higher officer as specified below:
 - a. Respective Deputy Director of Factories, in case of factory falling under the jurisdiction of the Asst. Director of Factories and Senior Asst. Director of Factories.
 - b. Respective Joint Director of Factories, which are falling under the jurisdiction of the Deputy Director of Factories.
3. The Concerned Joint Director of Factories and Deputy Director of Factories shall forward inspection report with other collected documents and materials to the jurisdictional officer for further follow up action.

All the officers of the department are strictly instructed to follow the procedures and carryout the inspections according to the computerised randomly selected factories.
