**CIRCULAR / NOTIFICATION**


The Department of Legal Metrology, under section 15 of the Legal Metrology General Act, 2009 and Rules should carry out the inspections on pre defined intervals. That objective of these inspections is for:

- Maintenance of accuracy in all Weights & Measures
- Protection of Consumer Interest
- Ensuring correct quantities for the prices paid
- Ensuring correct weighment of farm produced in sale & transaction

The Business Reform Action Plan for the State/UTs published by Government of India, calls for documentation of the inspections done by the department. Also, the action plan indicates that the inspection reports shall be made available to the industry as and when the inspections have been done.

In order to achieve this henceforth all the Inspection reports are mandated to be processed through online.

In view of the above, it is directed to all the Inspectors & Officers, post the inspection of the premise shall upload the inspection reports within 48 hours of inspection on the portal which would be available for viewing the downloading by the users.
