ORDER:

As per the recommendation No: (Action Point)203, 204, 205 & 206 of DPIIT under the State Level Business Reforms Action Plan (SBRAP) for the year 2020-21, it is mandatory on the part of the Legal Metrology Department to design and implement a system which is capable of

1. Identifying the licenses that need to be inspected.
2. Computerized allocation of Inspecting officers.
3. Allowing the users to view and download submitted Inspection reports of at least past 3 years.

For implementing the above reforms, the procedure, checklist (documents) and the Risk based Criteria should be made available on the Department's Website. With regard to Point No. 1 above, the identification of licenses for the purpose of inspection is taken up on the basis of Rule 27 of Legal Metrology (General) Rules 2011.

The following are the types of licenses/weights and measures where inspections are subjected:

- (i) Types of weights and measures subjected for inspection:

1	Storage Tanks.
2	All weights, capacity measures, length measures, tape , beam scale and counter machine.
3	All weight or measure including tank lorry other than weights, Capacity measures, length measures, tape, beam scale and counter machine and storage tanks.

(ii) Types of licenses subjected for inspection:

1	Manufacturing License of all weight or measure other than Storage Tanks.
2	Manufacturing License of Storage Tanks.
3	Repairing License of all weights, capacity measures, length measures, tape . beam scale and counter machine.
4	Repairing License of all weight or measure including tank lorry other than weights, capacity measures, length measures, tape, beam scale and counter machine and storage tanks.
5	Repairing License (Calibration) of Storage Tanks.
6	Dealing License for all weight or measure.

Accordingly, depending upon the periodic necessity of renewal and inspection the licenses of Manufacturing, Repairing, and Dealing of Weight or Measure are classified into 3 risk categories. The following are the risk criteria and frequency of inspection used to identify licenses that need to be inspected.

Frequency & Risk Category of inspection of licenses.

a. Manufacturer

1	Manufacturing License of Storage Tanks	Low	36 months
2	Manufacturing License of all weight or measure other than Storage Tanks	High	12 months

b. Repairer

Sl No.	Description of Weight or measure to be inspected and Verified	Risk Category	At least Periodicity
1	Repairing License (Calibration) of Storage Tanks	Low	36 months
2	Repairing License of all weights, capacity measures. length measures, tape. beam scale and counter machine	Medium	24 months
3	Repairing License of all weight or measure including tank lorry other than weights, capacity measures, length measures, tape, beam scale and counter machine and storage tanks	High	12 months

c. Dealer

SI No.	Description of Weight or measure to be inspected and Verified	Risk Category	At least periodicity
1	Dealing License for all weight or measure	High	12 months

Based on the above categorization, the computer in the Central Inspection System automatically allocates the Inspecting Officer for inspection on a random basis.

Accordingly all the authorized LMOs (all DCs, ACs & ILMs) directed to strictly follow the above said guidelines for conducting the inspections of license premises at the time of issue and renewal of licenses. It is also directed that all inspections, as allocated randomly, are to be carried out as per the schedule and the inspection reports are uploaded online within 48 hours of inspection.
